Jim Theisen dies at age 82. Jim was in the ICU after cancer surgery and passed away some days later on February 28, still in ICU with his family nearby.

Jim was a giant in senior softball circles. He is in the Senior Softball National Hall of Fame. His exploits were many over the years as a standout hitter and extremely fast runner and great fielder. He was a member of the Redwood City Señors Softball Club whose team won the National Championship in 1989 before there were so many divisions and categories. He went 23 for 24 in that tournament!

In addition to his softball prowess, Jim was well-liked. Always a fierce competitor he was also generous with his time and possessions and befriended many, many other players of all ages and abilities. He will be greatly missed and Theisen "stories" about him will be told for years.
